Begin Your Journey

Fill out questionnaires & provide documents; we do the rest. Ask your questions and get answers!

File Application

We'll finalize, scan & mail your application package to USCIS with tracking and provide you the details.



3-4 weeks

Receipt Notices

You'll receive a copy and so will our office. We'll make sure USCIS has done it's job properly.



4 weeks

Biometrics

Provide your fingerprints, photo and signature to USCIS. (Due to COVID, biometrics is taking longer for some applicants.)



6-7 months

Work Permit

Receive your work permit and work for anybody! Apply for a Driver's License and obtain your Social Security Number.



7-11 months

Interview Notice

We'll both receive copies of your interview notice.



14-28 months

Practice Interview

You'll meet with an attorney to practice for the interview. Ask your questions & get answers so you'll feel calm.



11-17 months

Interview

With an attorney at your side (or via telephonic appearance), if the officer requests more information, our team will follow up & respond.



12-18 months

Get a Green Card

You'll either have a 2- or 10- year green card. After 3 years, apply for citizenship!
